1. About COMEDK

The Karnataka Private Medical & Dental Colleges Association, and Karnataka Unaided Private Engineering Colleges Association in their endeavour to offer an effective, fair and objective testing procedure to determine merit of students wanting to seek admissions to the Under-Graduate Medical, Dental and Engineering courses of the Member Institutions, have formed "Consortium of Medical Engineering and Dental Colleges of Karnataka" COMEDK, has been assigned the task of organising a common entrance test for the academic year 2008-2009.

COMEDK entrance test & publication of test score and rank list will be followed by centralised counselling (Single window system). The details will be publicised in due course on our website, <u>http://www.comedk.org.</u>

The list of the Member Institutions who have indicated that they are participating in the COMEDK testing program, along with the courses offered by them, is published in this brochure, and also on our website <u>http://www.comedk.org</u>

Applicants are advised to read this brochure thoroughly and familiarise themselves with the test procedures.

Note: COMEDK's website http://www.comedk.org contains information and current updates/alerts. This site is updated regularly. COMEDK suggests all applicants to visit it frequently for relevant information.

2. Under-Graduate Medical, Dental and Engineering Courses

- > M.B.B.S. and B.D.S. courses are scheduled to begin from **01/08/2008**.
- > B.E. and B.Arch. courses are scheduled to begin from **01/09/2008**.

3. Eligibility Criteria

MBBS /BDS:

Candidates should have passed the qualifying examination which is 2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent examination, the last two years of study comprising of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) with English as a compulsory subject, must have passed these subjects individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% of marks taken together in PCB. In addition, in the competitive entrance test, must have secured not less than 50% marks in PCB.

In respect of candidates belonging to **SC**, **ST and Karnataka OBC**, the marks obtained in PCB taken together in qualifying examination should not be less than 40% and also score not less than 40% in the Competitive Entrance Test, for admission to MBBS. However for BDS a minimum of 50% is mandatory for all candidates both in qualifying examination (PCB) and Competitive Entrance Test. (Reference: DCI Letter No. DE 14-2004/1135 dated 05-May-2004). English as one of the language of study is compulsory.

B.E:

For General category students the minimum qualification for admission is a pass in the 2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent qualifying Examination with a minimum aggregate of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM Physics and Mathematics are compulsory subjects along with Biotechnology or Computer Science or Biology or Electronics as optional subjects in place of Chemistry, are eligible. English as one of the language of study is compulsory).

For **SC**, **ST** and **Karnataka OBC** students the aggregate marks in PCM should be not less than 40% in the qualifying examination, irrespective of marks secured in PCM subjects in the Competitive Entrance Test.

B. Arch

A candidate who has passed the qualifying examination (2nd PUC or 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent examination) with Mathematics as one of the subjects along with other subjects or a 10+3 Diploma recognized by Central / State Government and having obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% marks in case of SC/ST and Karnataka OBC Category candidates). Further the candidate should have appeared for National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) conducted by Council of Architecture.

COMEDK **will not** be conducting any competitive test separately for candidates seeking admission to B.Arch (Architecture Course) as per existing rules.

4. About Member Institutions

Unaided, private Medical, Dental and Engineering colleges which are members of COMEDK, across the State of Karnataka, offer various courses in Medical, Dental and Engineering studies at Under-Graduate level. The courses offered at the Under-Graduate level include MBBS, BDS and B.E. programs. Colleges which have indicated their willingness to make admission to their Under-Graduate courses based on merit in the Common Entrance Test organized by COMEDK (COMEDK UGET-2008), are listed in **Appendix – I**

(The information will be uploaded as and when the communication is received from the institutions)

Note:

- Minority status applicable to candidates of Karnataka origin only for admission to respective minority status colleges.
- Claims made by candidates as belonging to Karnataka origin or Religious or Linguistic minority status etc is not verified while sending TAT for COMEDK-UGET 2008. However, if such a candidate qualifies for attending centralized counseling, it will be his/her responsibility to furnish original documents issued by competent authorities to the satisfaction of COMEDK authorities, failing which such a candidate will be considered only under All India General Merit.
- Change of category status like SC, ST, OBC, Minority will not be entertained mid-way during the course of UGET 2008. As such students are cautioned to declare their status while filling the application.

4.2 Seats offered by Member Institutions:

4.3 Fee Structure

As per the Consensual Agreement with the Government of Karnataka following will be the **Annual Tuition Fee** for the seats to be filled through COMEDK test and Centralised Counseling should not exceed the fee given below:

Annual college wise and course wise fee fixed by each college will be published in due course.

5. COMEDK Under-Graduate Entrance Test-2008 (COMEDK UGET-2008)

COMEDK will conduct a separate entrance test for Medical Dental and Engineering Under-Graduate courses called 'COMEDK UGET-2008', for candidates seeking admission to MBBS, BDS and BE. The entrance test is being conducted for merit determination for use by COMEDK Member Institutions only. The COMEDK entrance test is mandatory for candidates seeking admissions for the Under-Graduate courses in Member Institutions. The COMEDK UGET-2008 test scores are valid only for admissions during the academic year 2008-2009.

The COMEDK UGET-2008 will be conducted across Karnataka on Sunday the 04th May 2008.

The test venue will be mentioned in the candidate's **Test Admission Ticket** and also on the website under every candidate's individual login.

Please visit the website for frequent changes and updates before leaving your hometown for the test.

5.1. Application Procedure

The process involves the following stages:

Note: Send the application in A4 size envelope only. Do not fold the application form

- Ensure that the Demand Draft for Rs.650/-(Rupees six hundred fifty only) if you intend to appear for MBBS/BDS(PCB) or BE(PCM) and Rs.850/-(Rupees eight hundred fifty only) for MBBS/BDS and BE(PCMB), to be kept ready before filling up the Online Application form, as you will have to enter the DD details.
- > The Online application form has to be filled up properly and completely.
- Take a print of the filled in Application form and Date of Birth Certificate/ Identity Proof.
- The Application form is said to be complete only if it is enclosed with all the documents mentioned below and mailed to COMEDK office.
- Multiple application form filled and received from the same candidate will result in confusion and may cause for disqualification.
- Multiple Demand Drafts if sent (Excess Amount) by the candidate will not be refunded.

Checklist of documents to accompany the completed Application Form:

- Demand Draft for Rs.650/- for MBBS/BDS(PCB) or BE(PCM) and Rs.850/- for MBBS/BDS and BE(PCMB) drawn in favour of COMEDK-2008 payable at Bangalore (mention your name and application number on the back of Demand Draft)DD submitted will not be refunded.
- COMEDK copy of Date of Birth Certificate/ Identity Proof in the prescribed form duly attested by the head of the institution last studied.
- Additional recent passport size photograph similar to the one pasted on the application. (mention your name and application number on the back of photograph)

Non-refundable fee for taking COMEDK UGET-2008 and attending centralised counselling, **if eligible**, is Rs.650/- for **MBBS/BDS(PCB) or BE(PCM)** and Rs.850/- for **MBBS/BDS and BE(PCMB)**. Demand Draft should be drawn in favour of COMEDK-2008, payable at Bangalore and should be enclosed with the application and all other relevant document after mentioning application number on the back of DD. **(If DD is not enclosed the application will be rejected.)**

Note:

Candidates are advised to visit COMEDK website regularly to watch for "Red Alert" list of incomplete applications to ensure corrections well in time and to enable COMEDK to send the Test Admission Ticket in time. Applicants are requested to send the filled-in application form at the earliest to avoid any delay. Please do not wait until the last date to send in your forms.

<u>Note:</u>

Please do note that the Photographs to be provided have to be identical, in Colour and clear, and should not be more than 6 months old. Application with smudged/tampered or hazy photograph will not be accepted. Any application received not adhering to these specifications is liable to be rejected without any clarifications and no refund would be made. The decision of the COMEDK Committee on this would be final and binding.

For all future correspondence with COMEDK UGET-2008, applicants need to quote their Application Number and TAT (Test Admission Ticket) Number (if applicable).

5.2. Test Admission Tickets and Related Information

Candidates appearing for COMEDK UGET-2008 will be issued a Test Admission Ticket (TAT) for identification. Candidates are required to bring the Test Admission Ticket and the original Date of Birth Certificate / Identity Proof (Candidate Copy) form duly attested by the Head of the Institution last studied, which is similar to the copy submitted (COMEDK Copy) along with the application form. This is mandatory.

The Test Admission Ticket gives the details of test centre assigned to the candidate. The candidates are assigned a test centre during the application processing, itself **and no requests for change in Test centre would be considered.**

The **Test Admission Tickets** would be dispatched to the candidates by speed post at the address mentioned in their application form as and when the applications are processed. However all **Test Admission Ticket** will be dispatched by **19/04/2008**. **Candidates not receiving the Test Admission Ticket on or before 25/04/2008**, must contact COMEDK help desk or send e-mail to have the details of the Test Admission Ticket.

Change of address, if any, during the process of COMEDK UGET-2008 must be intimated through <u>fax/e-mail to COMEDK office on or before 27/05/2008</u>; the responsibility for the same rests solely with the applicants. In the event of any candidate not receiving the **Test Admission Ticket** or misplacing the same, guidance can be obtained by calling COMEDK Help Desk. The help desk numbers are available in this brochure. Candidates can also view their test centre details in the COMEDK website <u>http://www.comedk.org</u> through applicant login.

6. Test and Related Information

The Entrance Test COMEDK UGET-2008 is mandatory for all candidates seeking admissions to Member Institutions of COMEDK. A merit / rank list is generated based on the candidate's scores in entrance test.

As part of our test process, to ensure fairness to the merited students and to eliminate fraudulent attempts, it is planned to use Biometrics (Fingerprinting) at various stages of the process and this would be done at the discretion of COMEDK.

6.1 Test Scheme

COMEDK UGET-2008 will have the following papers:

- {Combined paper for Physics and Chemistry} Compulsory for all the candidates appearing for COMEDK UGET-2008
- Biology Compulsory for the candidates aspiring for MBBS/BDS
- > Mathematics Compulsory for the candidates aspiring for BE
- A single test combining Physics and Chemistry subjects will be held on O4/05/2008 in the Forenoon Session (10.00 AM to 12.00 Noon). There will be a total of 120 questions: 60 questions in Physics and 60 questions in Chemistry. The test duration for combined paper is 120 minutes, and is compulsory for all candidates seeking admissions to M.B.B.S., B.D.S, and B.E. courses.
- Biology and Mathematics tests will be held on the same day 04/05/2008 in the Afternoon Session separately, with each subject having 60 questions with duration of 60 minutes. Candidates are free to choose any one or both the subjects. Biology Test will be conducted from (2.00 PM to 3.00PM) followed by Mathematics test from (3.30 PM to 4.30 PM).
- Candidates are required to mark their answers on an OMR sheet (Optical Mark Reader).
- > Correct answer for each question will be awarded one mark.
- > No Marks will be awarded for wrong answers.
- No Mark/s will be awarded for multiple marking (marking multiple responses) of any question.
- > There will be no negative marking.

6.2 Test Locations

The Entrance Test, COMEDK UGET-2008, will be held **in different cities/towns** across the state of Karnataka. The test will be held on the mentioned time and date in all the test centres. The details of all the test centres will be published online. The centre address will be mentioned in the TAT, which would be dispatched to the candidates prior to the examination as per the calendar of events.

6.3 Instructions to Test Takers

Candidates please note:

- Report 60 minutes before the commencement of the test (9:00am)
- Test commences at 10:00am
- Arriving later than 10:15 am is not permissible and you will not be allowed to take the test.

Answer sheet: All answers need to be registered on an Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheet, which is machine read and evaluated. Candidates must **use only blue or black ballpoint pen** for marking their answers on the OMR sheet. Use of pencils or erasers or whiteners is not permitted. (**Ref: Appendix - VI for format**)

- OMR answer sheets will be supplied only at the examination hall. After the test is over, the answer sheet should be given back, before leaving the room. Candidates are allowed to take the candidate's copy of the answer sheet only on completion of the test.
- Kindly note that the candidates must sign on their TAT and OMR answer sheets in the presence of the invigilator, after the invigilator has verified their TAT. Invigilators will also sign on the column indicating Invigilators Signature of the OMR Sheet. If however the signature or not affixed in the respective column of the OMR Sheet the sheet will be considered invalid and cannot be processed.
- Candidates are also required to write their name, question booklet number, version code, TAT number ONLY in the space provided in their OMR answer sheet.
- The OMR answer sheet is machine assessed and therefore it should be handled with care. If there is any doubt, please contact the test invigilator immediately.
- The COMEDK UGET-2008 test administration is timed. The test session is designed to be completed within the specified time as indicated in this brochure and no compromise will be made on the set time limits. The Chief Superintendent of the test centre is the official timekeeper. Candidates will not be permitted to continue the test beyond the established time limit.
- > It is planned to use biometrics (fingerprinting) during the test session.
- Candidates are not allowed to go out of the room temporarily for any reason during the test duration.

6.4 Grounds for Dismissal

The COMEDK UGET-2008 test administrator is authorised to dismiss a candidate from a test session for:

- > Attempting to take the test for someone else (Impersonation)
- > Failing to provide acceptable identification when asked for
- Creating disturbance at the test venue
- Giving or receiving unauthorised help
- > Eating or drinking during the test
- Using any forbidden / unauthorised testing aids, such as personal computational devices, pagers, cell phones etc
- Leaving the test centre before the stipulated time of 15 minutes, from the start of the test
- > Failing to adhere to any of the other procedures and regulations cited
- Refusing to follow directions as stipulated by the invigilators etc.

Requests for use of toilet during the test are not entertained.

Failure to comply with the test procedures and regulations or with the test administrator's directions can result in COMEDK taking action/s that include, but are not limited to, barring candidates from future testing and or cancelling your test scores. If your scores are cancelled, they will be reported to the Member Institutions / Regulating Authority, and your test fee will be forfeited.

6.5 Results Publishing

All answer sheets (OMR) are machine read. Key Answers and Test scores of all the candidates will be published on the website, <u>http://www.comedk.org</u>. Clarifications, if any, should be sought within the dates stipulated. Subsequently the final result along with the Merit List will be published which will be binding on all candidates and no further claim would be entertained thereafter. (Please refer to the Calendar of Events for details.)

The test results will be published in two stages:

- Test Score Publication
- Final Merit / Rank List Publication

The Final Merit / Rank List will be sent to the regulatory authorities. Individual rank card will be sent to all candidates. The same will also be made available at the COMEDK website, <u>http://www.comedk.org</u>

6.6 Test Scores Publishing

- Answer Keys to the COMEDK UGET-2008 will be published on the website only late in the evening, on 04/05/2008.
- Clarifications to the answer keys, if any, should be sought between 04/05/2008 and 09/05/2008. (Communications received after 09/05/2008 will not be entertained)
- > Test scores of COMEDK UGET-2008 will be published on **22/05/2008**.

- Clarifications to the Test Scores, if any, should be sought between 22/05/2008 and 27/05/2008. (Communications received after 27/05/2008 will not be entertained)
- > The Final Rank list will be published on 04/06/2008.

Applicants seeking any clarifications with regards to:

- a. Applicants seeking clarifications with regard to answer keys (<u>Ref:</u><u>Appendix 11 for format</u>) have to write to COMEDK, clearly indicating the grievance and with all necessary enclosures in a prescribed format which can be downloaded from our website. Every answer key for which clarification is sought should be sent to COMEDK office by post along with a Demand Draft of Rs.100/-(Rupees One Hundred only) per item, drawn in favour of 'COMEDK 2008', payable at Bangalore. Only if the clarification sought, is upheld, would the money be refunded.
- b. Applicants seeking clarifications with regard to Test score (<u>Ref: Appendix –</u> <u>III for format</u>) a Demand Draft of Rs.100/- (Rupees one Hundred only) per candidate, drawn in favour of 'COMEDK 2008', payable at Bangalore, should be enclosed along with a Candidate copy of the OMR sheet. Only if clarification sought is upheld, would the money be refunded.

No further claims for clarifications will be entertained by COMEDK after the last date, as indicated above.

6.7 Final Merit/Rank List Publishing

Any verifications / clarifications sought by the applicants will be put forth to the COMEDK's Academic Committee for their consideration and the decision given by the committee will be final and binding on all. No further claims will be considered. The final merit / rank list is generated based on the scores in the entrance test and the same will be published on **04/06/2008**.

INTER SE MERIT

Ties in the test scores, if any, will be resolved on the basis of the *Inter Se* Merit as defined below:

For Medical / Dental candidates:

- 1. Aggregate marks in Chemistry and Biology in the Entrance Test
- 2. Marks in Biology in the Entrance Test
- 3. Age of the Candidate, the elder candidate is ranked higher than the younger candidate.

For Engineering candidates:

- 1. Aggregate marks in Physics and Mathematics in the Entrance Test
- 2. Marks in Mathematics in the Entrance Test
- 3. Age of the Candidate, the elder candidate is ranked higher than the younger candidate.

For Architecture Candidates:

- 1.NATA Scores as submitted.
- 2. Marks in Mathematics of 2nd PUC or equivalent examination.
- 3. Age of the Candidate, the elder candidate is ranked higher than the younger candidate.

COMEDK Member Institutions will not accept any other qualification of entrance examination conducted by any other agencies to determine the inter-se merit.

All candidates must note that any form of canvassing or influence exercised would result in permanent disqualification of the application without any prior notice to the applicant. <u>http://www.comedk.org</u> is the only official website of the consortium, COMEDK is not responsible for information available on other websites / elsewhere.

Please note: COMEDK does not have any agents, liaison/admission offices, representatives or any other office/s other than the office mentioned in this brochure. Candidates are requested not to depend upon or deal with any person or organisation/s claiming to be associated with the COMEDK activities or claiming to help with admissions or entrance tests. COMEDK will not be responsible for the same.

7. Centralised Counselling (Single window)

Detailed instructions relating to centralised counselling will be put on the website at a later date.

First round of counselling **tentatively** will be held in the month of June 2008 Second round of counselling **tentatively** will be held in the month of Jul/Aug 2008

The COMEDK website <u>http://www.comedk.org</u> is updated regularly. COMEDK suggests all candidates to visit it frequently for relevant information.

8. Biometric Verifications

Candidates intending to take the Under-Graduate Entrance Test 2008 may be required to undergo biometric verification. (i) during the test, (ii) during centralised counselling for seat selection and (iii) at the college level, prior to the admission process.

To ensure fairness to the merited students and to eliminate fraudulent attempts, it is planned to use Biometric (Fingerprinting) at various stages of the process and this would be done at the discretion of COMEDK.

COMEDK reserves the right to change (or) reset the Biometric Verification parameters at any time during the selection process.

Any mismatch at any stage will automatically result in disqualification of the candidate and he/she will not be permitted to participate in any further process of seat selection and admission to UG course. Further, impostors are liable for criminal prosecution.

10. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ'S)

Q. When do the Courses begin?

A. Medical and Dental Courses are scheduled to begin from **01/08/2008**. Engineering and B.Arch courses are scheduled to begin from **01/09/2008**.

Q. What is the eligibility for the courses?

For M.B.B.S. & B.D.S:

Candidates should have passed the qualifying examination which is 2^{nd} PUC / 10+2 Higher secondary examination or equivalent examination, the last two years of study comprising of Physics, Chemistry and Biology with English as a compulsory subject, must have passed these subjects individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% of marks taken together in PCB. In addition, in the competitive entrance test must have secured not less than 50% marks in PCB.

In respect of candidates belonging to SC, ST and Karnataka OBC, the marks obtained in PCB taken together in qualifying examination should not be less than 40% and also score not less than 40% in the Competitive Entrance Test.

For B.E:

For General category students the minimum qualification for admission is a pass in the 2nd PUC / 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent qualifying Examination with a minimum aggregate of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM), irrespective of marks secured in PCM subjects in the Competitive Entrance Test. Physics and Mathematics are compulsory subjects along with chemistry / Biotechnology / Computer Science / Biology / Electronics as optional subjects with English as one of the language of study.

For SC, ST and Karnataka OBC students the aggregate marks in PCM should be not less than 40% in the qualifying examination, irrespective of marks secured in PCM subjects in the Competitive Entrance Test.

For B.Arch:

A candidate who has passed the qualifying examination (2nd PUC / 10+2 higher secondary or equivalent examination) with Mathematics as one of the subjects along with other subjects or a 10+3 Diploma recognized by central / State Government and having obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% marks in case of SC/ST and Karnataka OBC Category candidates).Further the candidate should have

appeared for National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) conducted by Council of Architecture.

COMEDK is not conducting any test separately for candidates seeking admission to B.Arch (Architecture Course) as per existing rules.

Q. Are the admissions open only to Karnataka students?

A. No, admissions are open to all the students across the country.

Q. Are candidates applying from outside the state of Karnataka eligible to get the benefit of lower eligibility qualifying marks?

A. Yes, in the case of SC and ST candidates only.

Q. Are candidates applying from the Karnataka state eligible to get the benefit of lower eligibility qualifying marks?

A. Yes, in the case of SC, ST and Karnataka OBC candidates can seek the benefit of lower eligibility in qualifying marks provided the OBC certificate as applicable issued by the competent authorities is furnished in support of the claim.

Q. I have finished my PUC/INTER/HSC/+2 a few years ago. Am I eligible for these courses?

A. Yes, you can apply for the notified courses, if you fulfill the eligibility requirements as mentioned.

Q. Is there an age limit for the course?

A. The candidates must be 17 years as of **31/12/2008** for M.B.B.S. and B.D.S. courses.

Q. Although I am eligible, I am currently enrolled in another course. Will I be permitted to join?

A. Yes, you are eligible to join if you have the basic eligibility as mentioned.

Q. I have completed my diploma course. Can I apply to COMEDK and its member colleges for 2^{nd} year / 3^{rd} semester?

A. No, this notification is only for admissions to the 1st year/semester in M.B.B.S., B.D.S., and B.E. Thus, you cannot apply for the 2nd Year (lateral entry scheme).

Q. How will I know my test results?

A. Test results are intimated to candidates. The results are also published on the web site.

Q. When is the last date to apply?

A. Completed application forms must reach the office of COMEDK on or before **10/04/2008**. Applications received after the last date will not be accepted.

Q. I wish to apply for Medical and Engineering courses. Should I apply for each of them separately or can I apply through a single application for both of them?

A. You can apply to any/all of Medical, Dental and Engineering courses in a single form. You can indicate your preferences for each of them in the same application form. You have to provide Rs.650 (DD) in case of you taking only MBBS/BDS (PCB) or BE (PCM). In case you are taking all the four subjects MBBS/BDS and BE (PCMB) you have to send a demand draft for Rs 850.

Q. Is there any minimum marks to be scored in COMEDK UGET-2008?

A. A candidate is required to secure a minimum of 50% for General category and 40% for those belonging to Schedule Caste / Schedule tribe and other backward Classes of Karnataka in the COMEDK UGET-2008 to be eligible for M.B.B.S.

- For BDS all candidates should secure a minimum of 50%
- For BE no minimum marks is prescribed but one has to appear for COMEDK Test.

Q. What is the fee structure?

A. Each COMEDK member institution is required to notify its fee structure as per the consensual agreement with the Government of Karnataka. Upper limit of Rs.3.25 lakhs for Medical, Rs.2.30 lakhs for Dental and Rs.1.25 lakhs for Engineering courses is fixed.

Q. Can I send a black & white photograph?

A. No, the Photograph to be provided has to be in Colour and clear and should not be more than 6 months old. Application with smudged/tampered or hazy photograph will not be accepted.

Q. If I have 5 clarifications in the answer key, then do I send a DD of Rs.100 or Rs.500? A. You have to send a DD of Rs.500. (Rs.100 per clarification) along with the format (Appendix- II of Brochure)

Q. I want to seek clarification of my test score. Should I send a DD for Rs. 100/-

A. Yes you have to send a DD for Rs.100/- along with the format of seeking test score clarification. (Appendix- III of Brochure)

Q. Would I get a refund for the amount, which I have sent along with my clarification/s? A. You would be entitled for a refund only if your clarification/s is/are upheld by the academic committee or your claim for clarification of test score is upheld.

Q. What is a minority Institution and who is eligible to be admitted under minority Quota? A. Minority institutions are broadly of two types – 1) Religious minority 2) Linguistic minority. The minority status is restricted to Karnataka Candidates only. Minority College is entitled to admit candidates from their own minority group only.
