where only one seller has a total command or control over the sale of a given article. Accelerating Inflation It means increasingly sharp rise in the rate of inflation. If government tries to hold unemployment below the natural rate of unemployment this will cause accelerating inflation.

Administered Price The prices which are the outcome of the regulation and control of the administrative machinery of the government. When due to scarcities on the excessive demand, the price that rules becomes high which the consumers find it difficult to pay, the government steps in as a special case to fix up the prices of certain essential or scarce products. Advalorem and Specific Duty Duty or tax imposed on the goods are broadly divided in two parts: (i) Specific: depends on the physical

attribute of the commodity and (ii) Advalorem: according to value i.e., as a percentage. Adverse Balance of Payment The aggregate imports of goods and services exceed the aggregate exports of a country, is called adverse

balance of payment. It is adverse for such a country as it becomes a debtor. Adverse Balance of Trade Unlike the adverse balance of payment (BOP), adverse balance of trade (BOT) includes the export and import of the merchandise-visible goods only. A nation with a

favourable balance of trade can have unfavourable balance of payment. Agricultural Productivity It refers to the output on the farm. It can be

studied from two angles-output per acre of land and output per farmer. Amalgamation It is the final form of monopoly combination. When two independent firms or limited companies constitute themselves into a single business entity losing their separate entity is called amalgamation. Amalgamation takes place with a veiw to effect

economics, reduce competition and capture markets.
