#### SECTION B: WRITING AND GRAMMAR

Q.3: Writing an Article/Descriptive Paragraph (person/place/event/diary entry) in about 100-150 words based on visual or verbal cue/s. The questions will be thematically based on the prescribed books. 8 marks

Q.4: Writing a short story based on a given outline or cue/s in about 150 - 200 words.

- Q.11. One out of two Long Answer Questions from the book MOMENTS on theme or plot involving interpretation, extrapolation beyond the text and inference or character sketch in about 100 to 150 words.

**NOTE :** Teachers are advised to :
