Prepare Manu's speech.



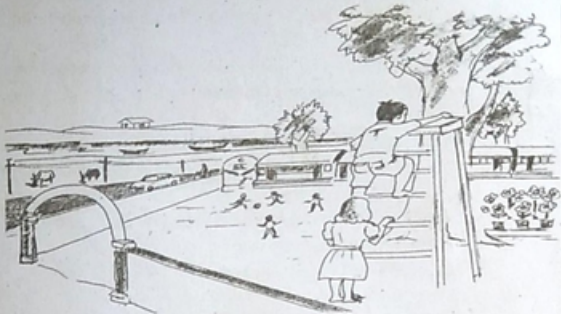
