ದಕ್ಷಿಣ ಕನ್ನಡ, ಉಡುಪಿ ಮತ್ತು ಕೊಡಗು ಜಿಲ್ಲೆಗಳ ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣದ ಅಗತ್ಯಗಳನ್ನು ಪೂರೈಸುವ ಉದ್ದೇಶದಿಂದ ಮಂಗಳೂರು ವಿಶವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯವು ಸಪ್ಟೆಂಬರ್ 10, 1980ರಂದು ಸ್ಥಾಪನೆಗೊಂಡಿತು. ಉನ್ನತ ಮತ್ತು ಹೆಚ್ಚಿನ ಶೈಕ್ಷಣಿಕ ಅಧ್ಯಯನ ಮತ್ತು ಸಂಶೋಧನೆಯ ಮುಖ್ಯ ಕೇಂದ್ರವಾಗಿರುವ ಮಂಗಳೂರು ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದ ಆವರಣವು ಪ್ರಾಕೃತಿಕವಾಗಿ ಸುಂದರವಾದ ತಾಣದಲ್ಲಿದೆ.

ಮಂಗಳೂರು ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯವು ನಮ್ಮ ನಾಡಿನ ಹೆಮ್ಮೆಯ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಒಂದು. ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣ ರಂಗದ ಪ್ರಾಚೀನ ಮತ್ತು ಪ್ರತ್ಯಿತವಾದ ಕೆಲವು ವಿದ್ಯಾ ಸಂಸ್ಥೆಗಳು ಮಂಗಳೂರು ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದ ಕಕ್ಷೆಯಲ್ಲಿ ಬರುತ್ತವೆ. ಮಂಗಳೂರು ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದ ಆವರಣದಲ್ಲಿ 25 ವಿಭಾಗಗಳಿದ್ದು, ಒಟ್ಟು 35 ಅಧ್ಯಯನ ವಿಷಯಗಳನ್ನು ಬೋಧಿಸಲಾಗುತ್ತಿದೆ. ಮಡಿಕೇರಿ ಕಾವೇರಿ ಕ್ಯಾಂಪಸ್ ನಲ್ಲಿ 2 ಸ್ನಾತಕೋತ್ತರ ವಿಭಾಗಗಳಿವೆ ಹಾಗೂ ವಿಶವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯ ಕಾಲೇಜು, ಮಂಗಳೂರಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಮೂರು ಸ್ನಾತಕೋತ್ತರ ವಿಷಯಗಳನ್ನು ಬೋಧಿಸಲಾಗುತ್ತಿದೆ.

ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯ ಆವರಣ, ಮಂಗಳಗಂಗೋತ್ರಿಯು ಮಂಗಳೂರು ನಗರದ ಆಗ್ನೇಯ ದಿಕ್ಕಿಗೆ ಸುಮಾರು 20 ಕಿ.ಮೀ. ದೂರದಲ್ಲಿದೆ. ಸುಮಾರು 333 ಎಕರೆಗಳಷ್ಟು ವಿಶಾಲವಾದ ಪ್ರದೇಶದಲ್ಲಿರುವ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದ ಆವರಣವು ತುಸು ಎತ್ತರದ ಭೂಭಾಗವಾಗಿದ್ದು, ಇದರ ಪಶ್ಚಿಮ ದಿಕ್ಕಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಅರಬ್ಬೀ ಸಮುದ್ರವೂ ಪೂರ್ವ ದಿಕ್ಕಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಪಶ್ಚಿಮ ಘಟ್ಟವೂ ಇದೆ. ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯವು ಸ್ಥಾಪನೆಯಾದಂದಿನಿಂದ ಉನ್ನತ ಶಿಕ್ಷಣ ಮತ್ತು ಸಂಶೋಧನೆಯ ಕ್ಷೇತ್ರದಲ್ಲಿ ಮಹತ್ವದ ಸಾಧನೆಯ ದಿಟ್ಟ ಹೆಜ್ಜೆಯನ್ನಿಡುತ್ತಾ ಸಾಗಿ ಬಂದಿದೆ.

ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದ ಆವರಣದಲ್ಲಿ ಹಲವು ಸೌಲಭ್ಯಗಳನ್ನು ಕಲ್ಪಿಸಲಾಗಿದೆ. ಪುರುಷರು ಮತ್ತು ಮಹಿಳೆಯರಿಗಾಗಿ ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿ ನಿಲಯಗಳ ಸೌಲಭ್ಯವನ್ನು ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯವು ಹೊಂದಿದೆ. ಸುಸಜ್ಜಿತವಾದ ಗ್ರಂಥಾಲಯ, ಗಣಕ ಕೇಂದ್ರ, ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯ ವಿಜ್ಞಾನ ಉಪಕರಣ ಕೇಂದ್ರ, ಮೈಕ್ರೊಟ್ರೋನ್ ಸೆಂಟರ್, ಆರೋಗ್ಯ ಕೇಂದ್ರ, ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಧಾಮ, ಯಕ್ಷಗಾನ ಕಲಾ ಕೇಂದ್ರ, ಮಂಗಳ ಸಭಾಂಗಣ ಮೊದಲಾದ ಸೌಲಭ್ಯಗಳಿವೆ. ಮಾತ್ರವಲ್ಲದೆ, ಆಂಗ್ಲ ಮಾಧ್ಯಮದ ಪ್ರಾಥಮಿಕ, ಪ್ರೌಢಶಾಲೆ, ಪದವಿ ಪೂರ್ವ ಕಾಲೇಜು, ವಾಣಿಜ್ಯ ಸಂಕೀರ್ಣ ಹಾಗೂ ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯ ಉದ್ಯೋಗಿಗಳ ಸಹಕಾರಿ ಸಂಘ ಇವು ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದ ಆವರಣದಲ್ಲಿವೆ. ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯವು ಸುಸಜ್ಜಿತವಾದ ಅತಿಥಿ ಗೃಹಗಳನ್ನು ಹೊಂದಿದೆ. ಇವುಗಳಲ್ಲದೆ ಉಪಹಾರ ಗೃಹ, ಬ್ಯಾಂಕುಗಳು, ಅಂಚೆ ಕಛೇರಿ ಮತ್ತು ಇತರ ಆಧುನಿಕ ಸಂಪರ್ಕ ಸೌಕರ್ಯಗಳು ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದ ಆವರಣದಲ್ಲಿ ಲಭ್ಯ ಇವೆ. ವಿಶ್ವವಿದ್ಯಾನಿಲಯದ ಆವರಣಕ್ಕೆ ಅತ್ಯುತ್ತಮ ಸಾರಿಗೆ ಸಂಪರ್ಕ ಸೌಲಭ್ಯವಿದೆ.

INTRODUCTION

Mangalore University was established on September 10, 1980 to cater to the higher educational needs of Dakshina Kannada, Udupi and Kodagu Districts. The University Campus is situated in a picturesque location and is a major centre for advanced academic studies and research.

Although Mangalore University is one of the youngest Universities in the country, it has within its ambit some of the oldest and prestigious institutions of higher learning. There are 25 post graduate departments on the University Campus offering 35 postgraduate courses. Two postgraduate departments at P.G. Centre Cauvery Campus, Madikeri offering two postgraduate courses and three postgraduate courses are offered at University College, Mangalore.

The University Campus at Mangalagangothri is located at a distance of about 20 Km. south-east of the city of Mangalore. The campus is spread over an area of about 333 acres and is on a high elevation overlooking the Arabian Sea on one side and the Western Ghats on the other. Since its establishment, the University has made considerable progress in the field of higher education and research.

The campus has hostel facilities both for men and women. The central facilities on the campus include a well equipped Library, Computer Centre, University Science Instrumentation Centre, Microtron Centre, Health Centre, Student Centre and Yakshagana Kala Kendra, Mangala Auditorium. An English Medium High School, Pre-University College, shopping complex and The University Employees Co-operative Society are located on the Campus. There are well furnished two guest houses on the Campus. A Canteen, Bank, Post Office and other modern communication facilities are also available on the Campus. The Campus also has good facilities for Sports and Games.

Besides sports, short-term programmes for Staff and Students in Yoga are frequently conducted by the University. Lectures, workshops and training programmes are organized under different endowment chairs.

The co-curricular and cultural activities reflecting the multicultural ambience of the region are conducted on the campus. The Prasaranga unit is engaged in the dissemination of knowledge and a separate cell to cater to the needs of SC and ST students are housed on the Campus.

SI. No.	Subject	Eligibility (See also note on page no.11)
1	Economics	Candidates who have passed the three year B.A. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent there to with Economics as major/optional subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in the subject.
2	English	 Candidates who have passed the three year B.A. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with English as major/ optional/special subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in English. Candidates who have passed the respective language/ literature as a minor subject or first/second language/Additional English at the degree level are also eligible provided they have secured not less than 60% marks in aggregate in the respective minor subject, first/ second language/Additional English. These marks are to be equated with the marks of optional English (the cognate subject) as follows: 1. 60% in English as first/second language is equal to 45% of optional English (the cognate subject) 2. 60% in English as minor subject/Additional English is equal to 48% of optional English (the cognate subject)
3	History	Candidates who have passed the three year B.A. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent there to with History/Ancient History/Archeology as major/optional subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in the subject.
4.	Kannada	Candidates who have passed the three year B.A. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with Kannada as major/optional subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in Kannada. Candidates who have passed the respective language / literature as a minor subject or first/ second language at the degree level are also eligible provided they have secured not less than 60% marks in aggregate in the respective subject as a minor or first / second language. These marks are to be equated with marks of optional Kannada in the ratio of 60:45.
5		Candidates who have passed any Bachelor Degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% marks (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) in aggregate including languages and Group III subjects. Selection of candidates shall be on merit-cum-reservation on the basis of 50:50 weightage for marks in the entrance and qualifying examinations.

7	Political Science Sociology	Candidates who have passed the three year B.A. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with Political Science as major/optional subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in the subject. Candidates who have passed the three year B.A. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with Sociology as major/optional subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in the subject.
8	Master of Social Work (M.S.W.)	Candidates who have passed any Bachelor Degree examination of Mangalore University or any other considered as equivalent thereto are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/ Category-I candidates) marks in optionals. Selection of candidates shall be on merit- cum-reservation on the basis of 50:50 weightage for marks in the entrance and qualifying examinations.
9.	Sanskrit	Candidates who have passed the three year B.A. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with Sanskrit as major/optional subject are eligible for admission to the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in Sanskrit. Candidates who have passed the respective language / literature as a minor subject or first/ second language at the degree level are also eligible provided they have secured not less than 60% marks in aggregate in the respective subject as a minor or first/ second language. These marks are to be equated with marks of optional Sanskrit in the ratio of 60:45. Candidates who have passed Vidwatmadhyama conducted by the Karnataka Secondary Education Examination Board, Bangalore or Shastri/ Prakshiromani of Sanskrit Universities/Deemed Universities or Praveen Examinations conducted by the Endowment Department of Karnataka Government or any other degree equivalent thereto or B.A.M.S./ B.N.Y.S. or any other degree equivalent thereto are also eligible. Candidates holding post graduate diploma in Sanskrit of any Indian University are also eligible for the programme.

Note : Candidates who have passed the B.A. Ed. Degree Examination (Regional College Scheme) are eligible for the PG Programmes in the Faculty of Arts provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC / ST/ Category I candidates) marks in the relevant subjects and fulfill other conditions specified for the above programmes.

Applied Zoology	Candidates who have passed the three year B.Sc. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent there to with Zoology as optional/ major/ special subject with a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in the subject are eligible for the programme.
3.	Biochemistry	Candidates who have passed the three year B.Sc. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with Biochemistry/Chemistry as optional/ major/special subject and any two of the following subjects - Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Biotechnology, Pharmacognocy and Chemistry as major / optional / minor / subsidiary subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/ Category-I candidates) marks in Biochemistry/Chemistry.
4.	Biosciences	Candidates who have passed the three year B.Sc. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent there to with any two of the following subjects - Botany, Zoology, Microbiology Biotechnology, Pharmacognocy and Environmental Science as optional / major / special subjects and also studied Chemistry / Biochemistry as optional / major / special subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in the subjects. However, in the case of U.G. programmes where there is one major and two minor/ subsidiary subjects, the candidates shall have studied one of the following subjects - Botany, Zoology, Microbiology and Environmental Science as major / special subject and the second as the minor/subsidiary in addition to studying Chemistry / Biochemistry as minor / subsidiary subject.

COMPUTER AND INTERNET FACILITIES

All the departments/offices have their own computational facilities with access to internet round the clock. Campuswide network connects over 800 computers across all departments on the campus and provides internet services with bandwidth upto 1 Gbps. Cyber lab at computer centre provides access to computational and internet services to students, faculty and administrative staff on the campus.

AUTHORITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

The Authorities of the University are the Syndicate, the Academic Council, the Finance Committee, the Boards of Studies, the Faculties and the Planning, Monitoring and Evaluation Board. The University is governed by the Karnataka State Universities' Act, 2000.

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

Mangalore University has introduced the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) (Semester Scheme) from the academic year 2011-12. In the emerging scenario of Internationalization of Indian Higher Education, it is imperative that the Universities should follow this system so that the mobility of students both within the country and across the globe becomes possible. The CBCS places the courses of the University on par with the global academic standards and evaluation strategies.

Under this system, each course in a programme will carry certain number of credits, which represent the weightage of a course. The credits are based on the number of instructional hours per week, generally 1 credit per hour of instruction in theory or 2 hours of practicals or project work or internship per week. Based on these, two -years four -semester post-graduate degree programmes will have 22 to 26 credits per semester and a total of 100 credits per post-graduate degree programme. The final results are declared in terms of the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) with the corresponding alpha-sign grade, in the eight point grading system.

One choice based course of 4 credits will be offered in the third semester of the programme either with in or across the faculties. Students in the III Semester have to compulsorily choose a course/paper of 4 credits from any other PG department / college having PG courses either within or across the faculties.

LIBRARY

Mangalore University has a spacious library having about 2,00,000 books, about 23,000 back volumes apart from reports, theses etc. covering a wide variety of subjects. It has a good collection of about 270 research and general interest journals on wide range of subjects. It has access to over 7500 journals in Full Text from UGC-INFONET. Besides, Audio-visual facility, Computer Aided Retrieval, CD-ROM Work Station and Reprographic Service (Xerox) are available in the Library. Cyber lab with 50 seats is available for accessing e-journals.

HOSTEL FACILITIES

The University has three (Men, Women and Working Women) well furnished hostels with the following facilities: 24 hrs security, Solar water heater, water purifier, Power generator back up, well furnished guest rooms, meditation room, Indoor sports facilities, Library, Emergency medicine and conveyance to hospital.

CAFETERIA

There is a centrally located canteen on the University campus, which caters to the needs of students, faculty and the general public.

HEALTH CENTRE

There is a health centre on the campus to take care of the medical needs of students, faculty and officials of the University.

STUDENT WELFARE

A separate Directorate of Student Welfare looks after the student welfare programmes in the University. The students are encouraged to participate in cocurricular activities such as literary and cultural competitions, inter-collegiate and inter-university competitions. The State / Zonal /National / International youth festivals are also arranged from time to time.

SPECIAL CELL FOR SC/ST

A special Cell for the welfare of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Mangalore University has come into existence for effective implementation of the programmes and policies of reservation.

The Cell awards SC/ST research fellowships and contingency grants to the Ph.D. students. It also extends financial assistance to various programmes such as study tour, preparation of dissertation/ project reports, purchase of sports kits and computer training. Training programmes for the SC/ST students appearing for UGC/JRF/Lectureship examinations, facilities awareness programme, career guidance and personality development programmes are also conducted.

A database of the SC/ST students studying in the affiliated colleges of Mangalore University and Post Graduate departments of Mangalore University is maintained in the SC/ST Cell.

SC/ST cell is in charge of getting scholarships, EBL charges of the hostel inmates and reim bursement of fees from the Government for SC/ST students studying in the P.G. departments. It also functions as a grievance redressal all for the SC/ST students.

SPORTS FACILITIES

A separate Directorate of Physical Education looks after the sports activities. The campus has a sports field, tennis courts, gymnasium and Indoor games stadium that cater to the needs of students, faculty and sports lovers.

POSTAL & BANKING SERVICE

A full fledged Post Office is located in the Science faculty building. The State Bank of India and Vijaya Bank are functioning with ATM facilities.

TRANSPORT SERVICES

Transport facility is available from all corners of the city with a frequency of 5 minutes. The campus is about 20 kms. from the Mangalore central bus station as well as the Mangalore central railway station.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES

The administrative offices of the University are housed in the Administrative Building, Mangalagangothri, Konaje. The offices of the Vice-Chancellor, the Registrar, the Registrar (Evaluation) and the Finance Officer are located in this building.

EMPLOYMENT, INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE BUREAU

The University Employment, Information and Guidance Bureau, located in the separate building at Mangalagangothri campus, provides information on courses and careers. Lectures and seminars are arranged in various colleges to highlight employment opportunities. Information about courses in other universities within the country and abroad are also provided. Students can register their names for employment assistance at the bureau.
