Ideology	Fascism	Nazism
Purity of Race	Kept up the purity of ancient Roman empire	Hitler opined Aryans were to rule the world and projected the purity of the Aryan race.
Annihiliation of enemies	Declared socialists, workers and peasant leaders as the enemies. Those who stood against fascism were sentenced to death.	Killed the socialists, Jews, communists and democrats.
Military dictatorship	"Black shirts" were used to suppress the anti fascism	"Brown shirts" and the "Gestapo" in charge of assault massacre of Jews.
Aggressive foreign policy	Mussolini through violence revolted against Ethiopia and Albania. Italy's run for dictatorship led for the outbreak of another war.	Hitler waged war against Austria-Czechoslovakia. Militant forces were made with Italy and Japan, other countries were joined against this and it led to the outbreak of another war.
