### TYPES OF SENTENCES, SUBJECT-PREDICATE

**Assertive Sentences**  
Sentence which declares or asserts a statement, feeling, opinion, incident, event, etc.

**Interrogative Sentences**  
Sentence that asks a question rather than. It always ends with a question mark(?)

**Imperative Sentences**  
Sentence that gives advice, instructions, a command, an order, a direction, a suggestion or a request.

**Exclamatory Sentences**  
Sentence that expresses strong feelings or emotions by making an exclamation. It ends with mark '!'

### Predicate

It is the part that contains the action.  
It tells what the subject does.

### Subject

The person or thing doing an action.  
It tells who or what the sentence is about.

**Eg:** The tiger roared at the audience.

**Subject:** The tiger

**Predicate:** roared at the audience
