Read the paragraphs 5 to 8 of the story 'The Scholarship Jacket' and answer the following questions.

1. Who were arguing when Martha reached her classroom to collect her P.E. Shorts?

Ans: Mr. Schmit, the history teacher and Mr. Boone, the Maths teacher.

2. What was the topic of their argument?

Ans: Martha was the topic of their argument

3. Identify the word from the passage which means 'to listen secretly to a private conversation. *Ans: Eavesdrop.*

4. How did Marta feel when she realised that the argument was about her?

Ans: It was a real shock for her. It felt as if she was trying to blend in with the graffiti written on the wall.

Ans: It was by chance she came to overhear the conversation between the teachers and later she was summoned by the Principal to tell her about that.


11. Why was the principal uncomfortable and unhappy?

13. Identify the word from the eighth paragraph which means 'extreme sorrow or pain'. *Ans: Dismay*


