Lines 5 - 7 speak about the need for righteous behaviour in the face of unrighteousness. How far do you agree? An ideal person ought to follow the righteous path, even if the people around him are engaging in evil ways.

What is the poet's approach to dreams and longings?

According to the poet, one should have a balanced approach towards dreams and longings. Dreams and longings should not be allowed to take an upper hand in your life and destroy your peace of mind.

The poet believes that success comes from self-control and a true sense of the value of things. Express your views on this.

I agree with the poet's viewpoints. In order to achieve success in life, one may have to take a lot of risk, keeping in mind the true sense of the value of things. You ought to hold on, even if losses take place on the way.

'Never breathe a word about your loss'. What impression do you get about the poet when you read this?

The poet seems to be a resilient person. He is not upset by the losses. He is highly optimistic, even at the time of loss. He believes in the adage : "Failures are the pillars of success".

What is the message conveyed in the last stanza of the poem?

The last stanza conveys the idea that an ideal person should be a social being, without sacrificing his own character at the same time. He should lead a balanced life. He should not be affected by the behaviour of either foes or friends.
