10. Appreciation

William Butler Yeats' poem 'The Ballad of Father Gilligan' tells us the moving story of Reverent Father Peter Gilligan and God Almighty's timely intervention to help him. The poem is written in the form of a ballad with a self-contained story, which depends more on imagery than description. Father Gilligan had to give funeral rites to the deceased and the last communion to the dying.

The setting of the poem is in the countryside. Moreover, we can say that the setting was in the Irish countryside because Yeats was Irish. The priest is tired after rushing from one place to another. He had to attend the dead and the dying. To show his restless mood, the poet gives these lines. The poem contains twelve stanzas of 4 lines each.

The central theme of the poem is to show that God is merciful. He sends help for those in need and at times when they need it the most. The tone of the poem is sad depressing at first; with all the deaths of the poor people. It turns repentant when Father Gilligan asks for forgiveness for his outburst. Then it turns suspenseful.

Father Gilligan says that since people keep dying and since he is expected to be with them in their last hours, he is not getting any rest, he has no reason to feel happy, and he is never peaceful either. However, in the next moment, he regretted and apologize to God saying that it was his weary body that had spoken, and not he himself. Father Gilligan then knelt on the ground putting his folded hands on the chair before him. While praying in that position, he suddenly fell asleep. The evening went by, and a few stars appeared in the sky at nightfall.

Vivid imagery is used in the poem. The night and the stars, the moth hour, etc. are examples of imagery. The regular rhyme scheme is abcb. 'die – I', 'asleep – peep' are rhyming words. The poem is a literary ballad written in the ballad form. It has a narrative, couplets, common regional dialect and adventure, dramatic and simple.
