Noun phrase is generally defined as a word or a group of words in a sentence which together casts a noun. A noun phrase can be a one word. A pronoun is also a noun phrase.

A sentence has two parts. The subject part is usually a noun phrase. The noun phrase may consist of

A noun phrase is a group of words that consists of a noun. It modifies and together act as a noun. A noun phrase can be a noun, a pronoun or a group of words that does the function of a noun.

A noun phrase can be a subject, object, complement, adverbial, object of a preposition. In a phrase, the noun can be modified by a quantifier (all, some) determiners, adjective another noun etc.

Verb phrase. It is generally defined as a phrase composed of a at least one main verb, objects, complements, adverb phrase, prepositional phrase. It may be a singular main verb or it may have auxiliary verbs also.

A verb phrase consists of a helping verb or a main verb which may or may not be followed by other words.

The predicate part is usually a verb phrase. A verb phrase consists of a finite verb alone or a finite verb with some other words which give additional details about the verb.

Prepositional phrase. A prepositional phrase is the combination of a preposition and a noun phrase.
