Noun phrases and verb phrases

- Every English sentence has two parts **Subject part** and **Predicate part**.
- The most important part of the subject is a **noun**.
- The most important part of the predicate is the **verb**.
- Always the subject part will be a **Noun phrase** and predicate part will be a **Verb phrase**.

Identify the Noun Phrases and Verb Phrases in the following sentences.

1. A few local people took our permission to go with us.

- A few local people(**Noun phrase**) + took our permission to go with us(**Verb phrase**)
- 2. The cage on the lorry was covered.

3. I decided to play it safe.

4. Mr. Thorat reached the shooting location with the tiger.

Analysis of the noun phrase

A noun phrase has the following parts:

- ➔ Predeterminer
- ➔ Determiner
- ➔ Adjective
- ➔ Head Word(Noun)
- ➔ Prepositional Phrase
- ➔ Relative Clause

Predeterminers - All, half, most, half of, most of etc. **Determiners** are three:

- 1. Articles a, an, the
- 2. Possessives my, our, your, his, her, their, its etc.
- 3. Demonstratives this, that, these, those

Adjective – The word describes a noun

Head word – The important part of the noun phrase

Prepositional phrase – A phrase starts with a preposition

Relative clause – A clause which starts with a relative pronoun

* Predeterminer, Determiner, Adjective - come before the head word.

*Prepositional Phrase, Relative Clause - come after the head word.

<u>Phrase</u>

A group of words expressing a particular idea or meaning. <u>**Clause**</u> A unit consisting of a subject and verb.

Relative pronouns

Which, that, where, who, when etc.

Parts of a noun phrase



Predeterminer + Determiner + Adjective + Head Word(Noun) + Prepositional Phrase + Relative Clause

Eg:

1. The digital camera on the tripod which is very expensive closes in on Zahra.

The digital camera on the tripod which is very expensive – Noun phrase/subject closes in on Zahra – Verb phrase/predicate **Parts of the noun phrase** The – Determiner digital – Adjective camera – **Head word** on the tripod – Prepositional phrase which is very expensive – relative clause

2. All my friends in the village who presented the gifts are very rich.

All my friends in the village who presented the gifts - Noun phrase are very rich - Verb phrase **Parts of the noun phrase** All – Predeterminer my – Determiner friends - **Head word** in the village - Prepositional phrase who presented the gifts - relative clause
