The poem The Ballad of Father Gilligan was written by the irish poet W. B Yeats. In this poem the poet depicts the poverty and extreme religiosity of the Irish rural life of his time

The poem tells the story of an old priest Peter Gilligan. Half of his people in the parish were either in sick-bed or already dead due to an epidemic. Day and night Father Gilligan was in service of them and he was very tired and weak. He could not attend one sick-man's last communion, as he fell asleep in his chair. Realizing that he failed to do his duty, next day morning in great grief Father Gilligan rode on his horse to the man's house. Where, his wife told the priest that her husband had already died and she asked him why he came again. From her question Father understood that in his absence God had sent an angel to perform his duties. He knelt and cried in repentance and thanked God for His mercy.
