### Points to Remember:

- 1. A title should be given. It can be the name of the person whose profile is created.
- 2. All the hints given with the question should be developed into short sentences and arranged in the order they are given.
- 3. Sentences should be arranged in a way to make a short paragraph. The paragraph should have an effective beginning and ending.

Note: the birth date should always be introduced in the simple past passive form -

was born on (with a date and year- on 02 March 2000);

was born in (with only month - in March 2000 or year - in 2000).

Even when the author is dead, we use normally simple present tense to talk about his works, as "His works are......"
