	 After the death of SunYat-Sen, Chiang Kai-shek became the leader of the Kuomintang regime Mao Zedong became the Communist leader Chiang Kai-shek established a military dictatorship in China. When the communists opposed his policies, he dealt with them brutally. In 1934, the communists led the Long March under the leadership of Mao. In March, many agricultural lands and villages were seized from nobles and given to peasants. Mao's Red Army captured Kuomintang headquarters. Kaishak sought refuge in Taiwan. On October 1, 1949, China became the People's Republic of China under the leadership of Mao Zedong. Military alliances – triple Alliance triple Entente Aggressive Nationalism – grew in Germany and Italy. Moroccan crisis – fought between Germany and France over Morocco. Balkan Crisis – Difference of opinion between the countries of the Balkan Alliance over the partition of Turkey. The Assassination of the Austrian Prince – Austrian Crown Prince Francis Ferdinand was assassinated by a Serbian youth in Sarajevo, Bosnia.
