- d) Makes you more energetic

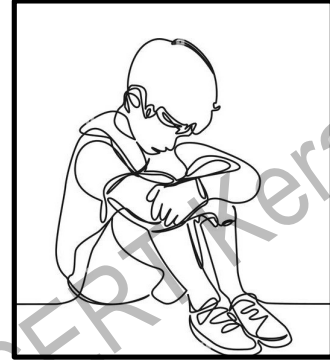
