BREAKTHROUGH: BRAILLE CODE INVENTED BY TEENAGER

Special Correspondent

Paris, 10 January 1824: Louis Braille, a 15-year-old student at the Royal School for the Blind in Paris, has invented a new alphabet system using raised dots. This code can be read by touch, allowing visually challenged people to read and write independently. Braille worked for years to simplify an earlier military code. His system uses just six dots arranged in two columns. Teachers and students at the school are thrilled with the invention. “This will change lives,” said Dr. Pignier, the headmaster. Braille’s invention promises to bring light to the world of the visually impaired.
