
B) Write the class and the amount which got the least collection?

- B) After some time the rooster came with 12 peas. The chickens divided them equally. How many peas will each chicken get?


- C) While starting to eat the chickens noticed that their parents haven't got anything to eat. So they collected all the peas together and divided equally for all of them. How many peas will each one get now?

A) Various activities of Thanvi in a day are given along with time. Draw the time in the clock.




