- What will he think about his friends in the forest?

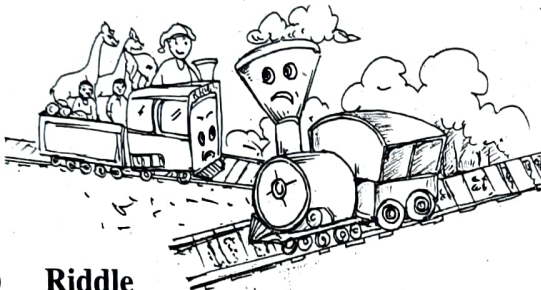

(4) Riddle

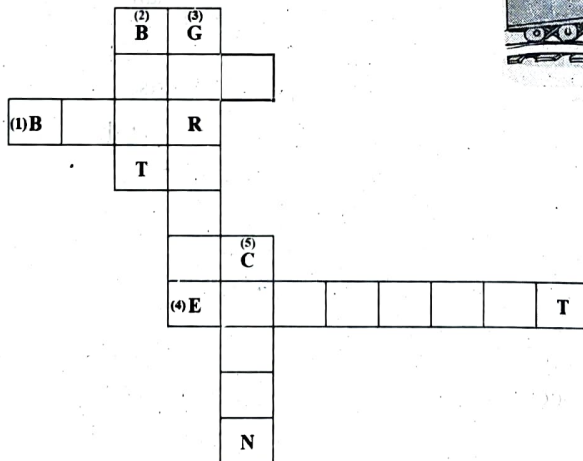
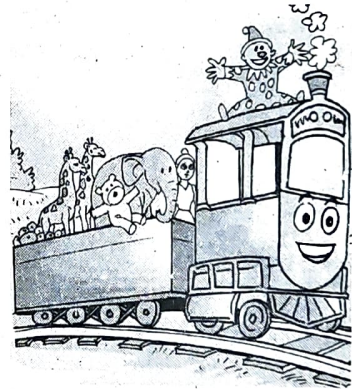
The Little Train ran along the tracks. Her carts were full of toys and dolls. Can you identify them.

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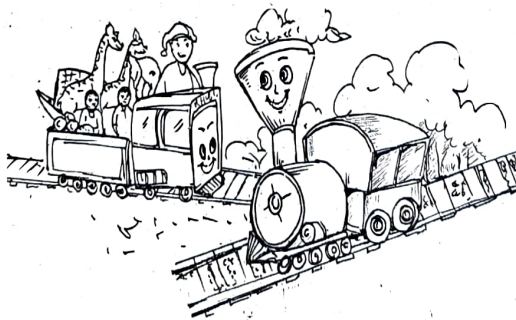
